1. Read Jude 20-23. How does he triage the 3 types of unbelievers that might be in the church? Why is it imperative we 'bring back' and 'snatch' these? What is at stake?
2. What are the two errors that threaten the wanderer? Which error has James been most concerned with?
3. Why does James insist that saving Faith is both Orthodoxy (right belief) and Orthopraxy (right action) who does he point to as an example (James 3:18-26)? See also Jesus in John 8:34-44
4. Are you a Saint calling the Wanderer or a Wanderer drifting from the Saints? What is repentance (Acts 3:19, Matt. 3:8, & the story of Luke 19:1-10)?
