Tozer said ***"A MAN CAN DIE OF STARVATION KNOWING ALL ABOUT BREAD, AND A MAN CAN REMAIN SPIRITUALLY DEAD WHILE KNOWING ALL THE HISTORIC FACTS OF CHRISTIANITY."***
